

Every Little (Square) Helps.....

Do you have any spare wool, a pair of needles and some time to help others? If so, please join us in creating lots and lots of knitted blankets for distribution in the run up to winter 2019.

We need squares of 10cm (or multiples of this) which we will sew into blankets of 1m square. To each blanket we will attach at least one knitted poppy, showing that we remember people in need each winter. (We have the poppies from last year's displays, so just squares required).

To knit a 10cm square using 4mm needles, double knitting wool and garter stitch in an average tension will require approx. 22st and 42 rows, however your own knitting may vary. That doesn't matter – just remember that sewing up will be much easier if we all stick to making 10cm squares!

Overleaf is a 10cm square, which you should use as a handy template.



If you would like to help this project, please start to knit your squares. There will be a 'get together' every second Monday, starting Mon 26th March, from 2.30 – 4.00pm in The Lounge at Trinity Church. You are welcome to join those sessions where we will knit, chat, and help to sew squares together.

We look forward to your support for the 2019 "Poppies with Purpose" effort.
